Rules

- Current Negative Coggins must be shown and a copy left with the show office
- Cross Entering division is allowed EXCEPT for the Future Hunter Division
- Show attire NOT required
- Boots and helmets REQUIRED for all riders
- Numbers required when mounted
- NO DOGS ALLOWED
- NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED

*Schooling/warm up for Future Hunter Division allowed in the show ring at 7:00 am – 7:30 am.

*15 minutes of limited schooling offered prior to each hunter division for that division's riders only. Outdoor warm up ring with warm up fences will be available all day. No jumper course schooling prior to classes.

Prizes

- Large classes will be split into Junior and Senior and pinned separately.
- Show management reserves the right to split or combine classes as entries warrant.
- All classes pinned 1st-6th
- Champion and Reserve Champion awarded in each division
